A Safe Passage

Walking down the busy, main road with cars, motorcycles, and busses whizzing by is a less than ideal way to get kids from one area to the next.

In order for our students to get to the soccer field where they have space to run around and play, or to the classrooms we are finishing renovating, this is how the kids must walk: down the main road and around the corner to the the Children's Ministry. It is very dangerous and a walk we try to avoid as much as possible.



Our hope is to be able to purchase the house that connects these two areas, but as of right now that isn't a possibility.



But as always, God provides a way!

After talking with our neighbors, we were able to purchase a small walkway that will be our connection! We have already opened up one side of the future passageway and taken out a lot of dirt but there is still a lot more work to do. We will need to open up the other side that connects to our current children's ministry playground, build a staircase to connect the two different levels, install two security gates, and build walls and a cement platform to hold our water pump and water supply tanks for the classrooms.

It may not look like much, but we are so excited for the safety it will provide our students.

Our goal is to have this project completed and ready to use when we begin the new school year in January. This would allow us to finish the work over Christmas break while our students aren't at the ministry since it will require construction work on the current playground.

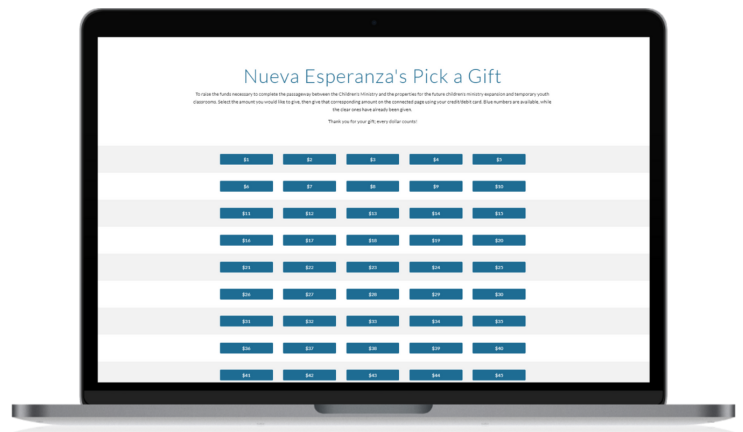


We have the property and the plan, now we just need the funds!

Fabiola's childhood was very sad as it was filled with anger, unfaithfulness, and abuse from her father. Since she was very young, it was her responsibility to take care of her younger siblings and help around the house because her mother worked long hours and her father did not contribute to the family. When she was 11, Fabiola tried to leave home to escape the abuse she experienced but was unsuccessful.



In high school, she wanted to study nursing but could not afford to; instead, she took a cosmetology course. Fabiola later got married and had a son, Kristian, who is enrolled at Nueva Esperanza. She became the main provider for the family because her husband struggled with alcoholism and was unable to keep a job. She worked at a shoe store, but in her spare time she would work in cosmetology to earn extra income. When the pandemic hit, Fabiola lost her job at the shoe store. Thankfully, she was able to continue providing for her family through her cosmetology clients and the business she had created. Recently Fabiola was even able to follow her dream to study nursing and get an internship in a hospital all because of the income she was able to make through her cosmetology earnings.

Cosmetology is one of the programs we plan to offer the students of Nueva Esperanza in the future **NE Career & Training Center**. In Fabiola's case, it was her experience and training in cosmetology and business that allowed her to provide for her family and put herself through university. The need is great for a facility that will give our students **HOPE** and allow them to gain the knowledge and experience they need in order to get and keep a job, as well as allow them to finish and further their education.
