# Hopes and Dreams for Future Generations

Diego and Ever are twins that came to Nueva Esperanza when they were three years old. Both boys are very bright and have done well in school. When they were thirteen years old, their mom left for Spain but things didn't end well for her. After three years of being raised by their grandmother and aunt and living from the funds their mother would send them, she returned to live with them physically and mentally ill. The tables have turned and now she depends on them 100% to take care of and support her and their grandmother.

Diego is sixteen years old and in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade. His interest in learning the trade of Barbering led him to an apprentice opportunity where he works eight hours each day learning the trade. He doesn't get paid, but the owner of the barber shop covers his transportation expenses. His goal is to become a barber in order to support his family. This arrangement has worked for him because this last school year has been online due to the pandemic. However, school will resume normal in-person classes in February and a decision will need to be made. Will he continue working as a barber to support the family or finish his high school education?



Barbering and Cosmetology are programs we plan to offer the students of Nueva Esperanza in the future NE Career & Training Center. Lack of

education and training is a common problem in Honduras for many young people desperate to work in order to provide for their family's basic needs. Many times this leaves them very vulnerable. A facility that will give **HOPE**, allow many to gain the knowledge and experience they need to get and to <u>keep</u> a job, and allow them to finish their high school education at the same time is greatly needed.

The reality of equipping, ministering, and educating the children who move from our children's ministry to our youth ministry is closer than ever! Building a safe and modern training facility will give these young people a foundation in trades that will allow them to escape the cycle of poverty that has been part of their families for so many generations. This will help them become productive and contributing citizens of Honduras. We know that many of you have shared in this long-awaited dream with us. 




## **Double Your Donation**
